The partition across the hallway from the KJR switchboard room interferes with the smooth handling of traffic and I am arranging with the Metropolitan Building Company to move the partition back approximately eight to ten feet. I am also making arrangements to have signs made to direct traffic to KJR studios, general offices and the KJR switchboard. The building company is today sending over men relative to moving the partition and the signs. Hope this meets with your approval.

I would like to make a suggestion about the bulletin board which is placed in the hallway next to the KOMO announcer's room. Bulletin boards are against the policy of the Metropolitan Building Company and this board is rather unsightly since papers attached blow around from the draft in the hall. It would seem to me that the proper place for this board is in the KOMO announcer's room and I suggest you move it.
