

With further reference to Homer Pope's letter of October 24, 1945, recommending the separation of remote control technical facilities, which has been approved by Birt F. Fisher and O. W. Fisher, it is requested that you make an equitable distribution between the two stations covering such remote control facilities, including automobile trucks, amplifiers, microphones, etc. etc. Also, that you record and furnish each station with discription of all equipment so distributed, and provide storage so that this equipment will be maintained in separate storage at all times, and see that all personnel are properly advised that the equipment will be separately owned by the two stations, and is not to be intermingled.
