Mr. Brott:

Attached are the ~~KOMO-KJR~~ inventory sheets with all items checked off or notations made.

The following discrepancies & additions are to be noted:

KJR short one 44A Microphone. (original lists show no such microphone)

KOMO short one Microphone stand. (possibly one previously allocated to KOMO Remote equipment)

Loose short stub table microphone stands in studios, unlisted, divided:

- 2 - KOMO
- 1 - KJR

Extra studio headphones divided:

- 1 WE - KOMO
- 1 Leg - KJR
- Organ WE phones - KJR

KOMO stamp & KJR stamp on 59 metal folding chairs, each. 118 intact chairs instead of 128.

KOMO stamp & KJR stamp on 10 music stands, each. 20 intact stands instead of 26.

Minor changes made where not practical to split equipment. Coins flipped for equipment where two of a kind existed. miscellaneous & valueless & obsolete equipment placed in two piles of equal value & coins flipped for decision. No sets split, instead swapped with items of equal value - viz: Kjr took screwdrivers; KOMO files in studio shop, KOMO took drill set; KJR socket wrench set, etc.

The following items not on inventory lists were discovered but have not yet been divided, pending your suggestions or decisions on their disposition:

- DIVIDED** 2+2 Old studio drapes - now stored in Skinner basement shop.
- Jensen 12" speaker in RCA cabinet - used by KJR in D Studio. - 32⁰⁰
- Salesmen's ^{control} portable playback - controlroom.
- 50A Microphone - sometimes used on sound effects - 10⁰⁰
- 88A Microphone - suspended in B Studio, for organ pickup. - 32⁰⁰
- ~~KJR Announcers room RCA speaker in wall box.~~
- ~~KOMO Large Metal Parts cabinet in plant basement shop.~~
- 872A Filament warm-up unit. Transmitter room. - 20⁰⁰
- ~~Intercom system (Talk-a-Phone) - Controlroom & shop.~~
- ~~CENTER SPEECH CABINET AT TRANSMITTER - 100⁰⁰~~
- TABLE - SKINNER DASH
